WESTBARD: Bob Cope

The County Council public hearing has been scheduled for Tuesday, January 26, 2016. No time is set as yet.

Westbard will be before the PHED Committee in March with a final Council vote expected by the end of March. Meetings with members of the Council should be scheduled for February and March with an emphasis on the CCCFH priorities (edges, Willett Creek, retaining neighborhood character and local services, no big box stores, density, etc.)

There was a discussion of the effort to undertake a petition drive in connection with the Council's consideration of the sector plan. The petition should be drafted by early January and should include about 3-4 broad bullet points that CCCFH wants to stress. Mr. Cope will work on a draft and will involve Mr. Knopf. Efforts will then be made to get the petition online with help from a volunteer. Approval of member associations should be obtained as soon as possible after the petition draft is available.

Each association should meet with Council Member Berliner as well as with the At-Large Council Members. Other Council Members will be met by CCCFH representative(s) in hopes of securing their support. Each association must get good attendance at the Council hearing on January 26.

WES: Mr. Guerci for Mr. Knopf

WES had requested an extension which was opposed by Mr. Knopf on the grounds that they had had 8 years to resolve the issues. The extension was denied and a hearing set for June 2, 2016.

NORMAN KNOPF MEMBERSHIP: Mr. Guerci

Because Mr. Knopf has moved, he no longer participates as a Brookdale resident. He was unanimously approved for participation in CCCFH as an individual member pursuant to Section 2 (a) of the CCCFH Bylaws, because of his long service to CCCFH.
